

Verification of Completion of Practicum Requirement for Doctoral Students

Department of Epidemiology

Adequate practical experience for doctoral students is defined as the completion of two meaningful field experiences or study conduct activities, each during one semester. These practicum activities are exclusive of any that are part of an existing course. The student's advisor assists with the selection of a minimum of two distinctly different, eligible activities, the time and effort required, and provides the final approval for the choice of activities. The student prepares a brief report at the conclusion of each activity, which is reviewed with the advisor and attached to this form. The advisor is not required to supervise the actual activities. These activities can be thematically or methodologically related to the doctoral research project. Reimbursement is neither required nor prohibited.
